IMPERATIVE VERBS

Definition

Imperative verbs are verbs that create imperative sentences, which give commands, instructions, or express requests or directives. These verbs essentially tell someone to do something.

Examples

- Come here quickly.
- Open your books, please.
- Eat your vegetables.
- **Drink** plenty of water on hot days.
- Read the instructions carefully.
- Wait your turn.
