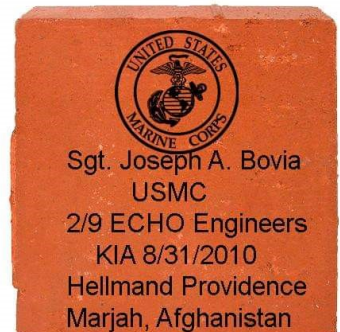

When children enter foster care, their greatest need is a stable, loving family. Over the past several years, Joey's Hope NOLA has helped make sure that children in foster care have just that!

Through a partnership with Crossroads NOLA, a local faith-based nonprofit that recruits, develops, and supports foster families, over 70 new foster families have been recruited and certified. These families have provided stable, loving homes to over 200 of the most vulnerable children in our community.

Many foster families have celebrated when the children in their care are able to be reunited with their biological family members. When reunification was not possible, foster families became forever families as they adopted the children they had grown to know and love.

Recently, we celebrated with the St. Cyr family as they finalized the adoption of their son, Samuel!
