About NextGen Enterprise

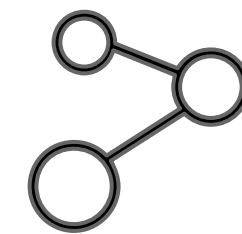

Students will learn key entrepreneurial skills to develop fictional business ideas and will be guided by a NextGen Coach. Students will then present their brand-new business plans to a wider audience



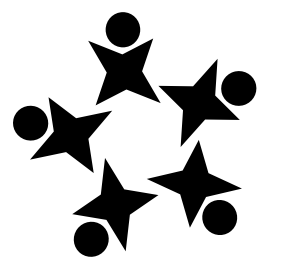

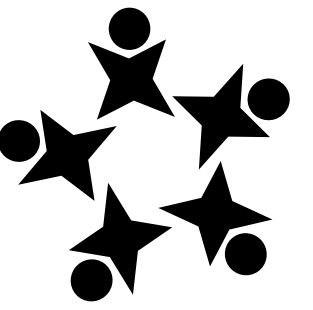
NextGen Business School

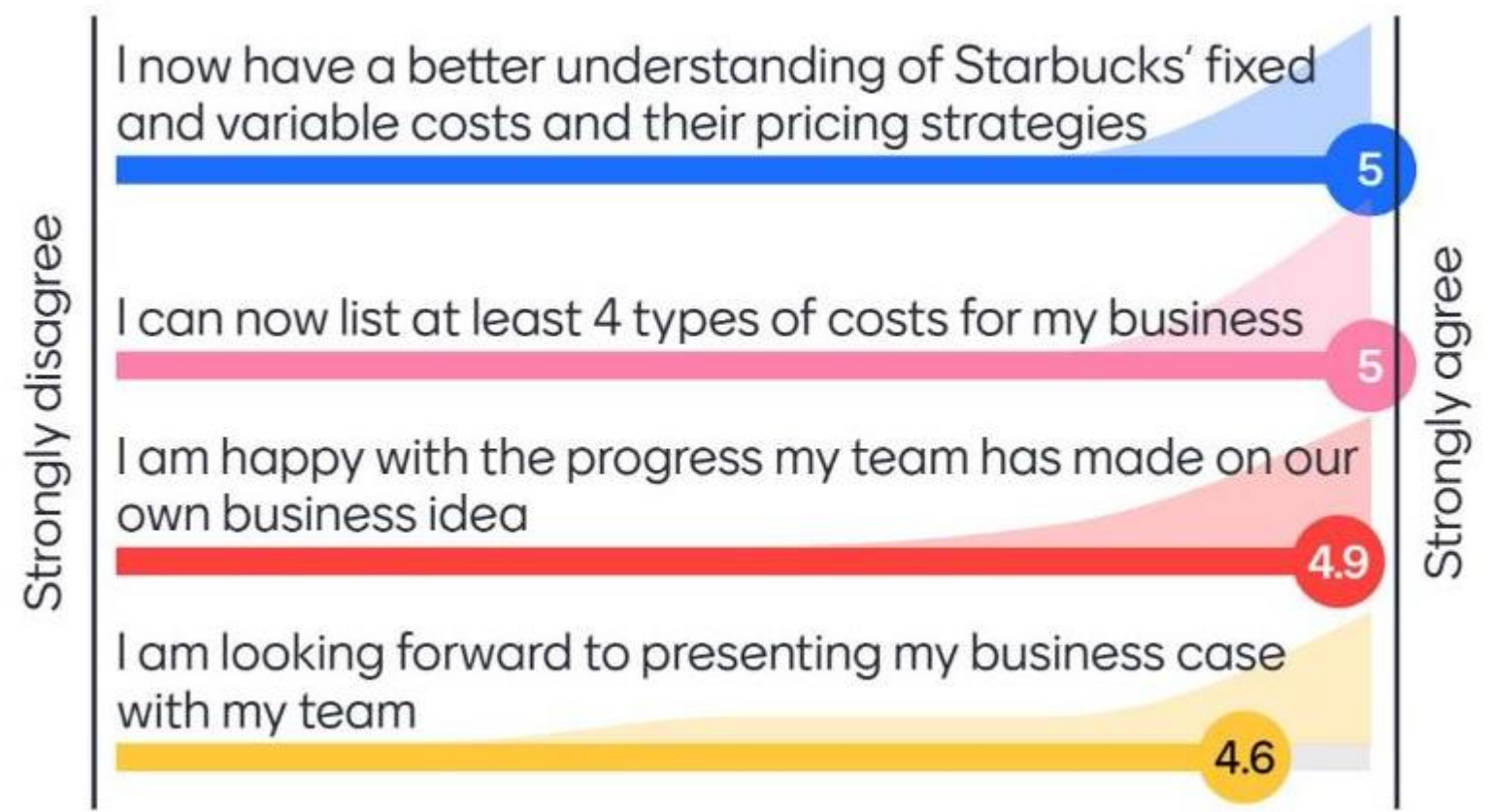

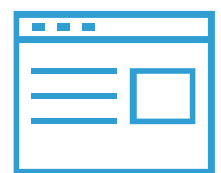

Throughout the course, students will gain practical experience and develop a foundational understanding of entrepreneurship. The NextGen Enterprise course will include:



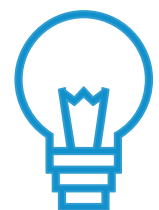
An exercise workbook will be provided for the student to complete during the virtual sessions

Technical Requirements

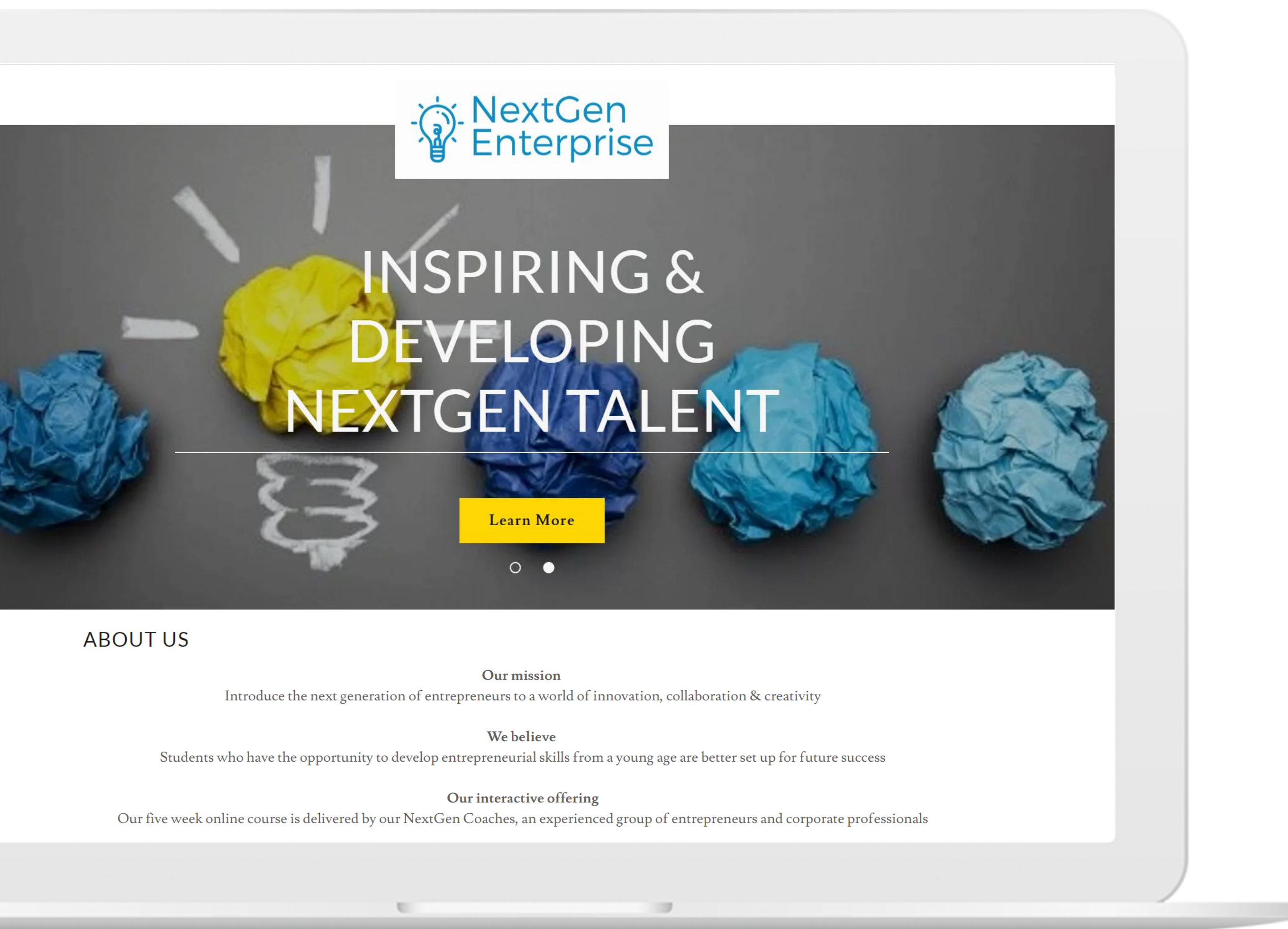
In order to complete the programme, students will need a current email account and access to a computer and the internet.
