Prerequisites: High School Diploma, or G.E.D.; United States Citizen, and or some form of proof that legalizes Your rights to work (naturalization & immigration papers or card), and or to take such courses.

The program offers telephonic lectures, which provides instructions that teaches and trains each student by a strict and direct itinerary. Students, who have a GPA of 74% , at the end of the program and have proven to successfully complete

the necessary requirement for clinical experiences; MAPT will award you a certification.

The program commences on Tuesday afternoons and Thursday afternoons; and possibly some weekend telephonic conferences.

Tuesday classes are: 5p-8:30p, Thursday classes are: 5:15p-8:45pm.

MPHL-101 & MPHL-102 consists of lectures, training students hands on experience, and a clinical experience that consist of:

20-procedures, with 160 recorded venipuncture to illustrate externally, 25-skin punctures, and 20-EKG's. Additional experience

Will include lab computer use, specimen processing, centrifugation and labeling.

Medical Training C-Fund Plan Requirements: *MAPT/Non-profit training w/Contributing fund*

The C-Fund is broken into 6 or five installments; or, full payments can be executed with above payments.

MPHL-101 Payment Plan Installments are monthly; 6 installments: Initial payment-1-\$350; 5-installments of: \$830

MPHL-102 Payment Plan Installments are: 6 installments: Initial payment-1-\$250; 5-installments of: \$650

BLS-Must be completed upon completion of MPHL-101 or MPHL-102; can be done online or at Red Cross or Community Center.

MAPT's public extended program, is a non-profit program, that awards each student a certificate with successful completion of all academics areas as well as the hands on experience class.

Prerequisites:

High School Diploma, or GED equivalent, some medical experience is appropriate, but not necessary.

The training program can consist of sending students out to clinical sites for additional training if necessary.

MAPT professional contracted trainees; assigned to MAPT, may achieve the professional certification with documented procedures.

All MAPT students are assigned liability coverage. All-students need an updated clinical clearance form-by a practicing clinician or NP. Students also need to complete a insurance release authorization form sent with liability coverage.

Additional prerequisites: Documentation of: MMR, TB or X-ray; r/o reactive PPD to verify NEG-CXR; varicella, and 3-series heptavax-vaccine.
