


# POP CULTURE REBUS<sup>TM</sup>

# Before You Start ...



A brief explanation and keys to solving the puzzles:

1. *The puzzles are solved using phonetics – the spelling does not count* (as inspired by the “Mad Gab”<sup>\*</sup> board game).
2. The plus sign **+** is used to combine two or more clues to reveal a singular word.
3. The dash sign **-** is mostly a pause for effect. If quotes are by more than one person, it would be placed directly at the front of each.
4. The forward slash sign **/** is a break in between sentences or quotes by more than one person.


The above diagram is an example on how to solve the puzzles:

- 1 Remove the T from the clue “hat.”
- 2 The arrow will point at the clue – in this case, a “pea.” (Adding both clues together will result with the word “happy.”)
- 3 Add the B in front of the clue “Earth,” resulting with the word “birth.” (Sometimes, when adding a letter or more, it would be placed anywhere in the word, depending on the clue.)
- 4 Remove the H from the clue “hay,” and add the D in its place (“day”). (Putting 3 and 4 together will result with the word “birthday.”)
- 5 The revealed puzzle is the phrase “Happy Birthday.”

Now let’s begin, and more importantly...HAVE FUN!





