

Today, I will show you how to crochet a small, cute bee!

Now before we start crocheting, we need a few notes on what colours and what materials we will use. For this pattern you can use any shade of colour of wool you like, as long as it is DK yarn. You could use a black and white combination or a navy blue with light turquoise, but in this pattern, I used yellow and black.

## **Abbreviations:**

MR - magic ring	ss – slip stich
st(s) - stitch(es)	dc inc - double crochet 2 in one stich
2sc - single crochet 2 in one stitch	dc - double crochet
sc2 - single crochet 2 in 2 stitches	hdc - half double crochet
[12] - 12 stiches at the end of the round	hdc inc - half double crochet 2 in one stitch
sc dec - single crochet 2 stitches together	

## What you will need...

-25g white dk yarn

-100g yellow dk yarn

-50g black dk yarn

-3.50mm crochet hook

-black embroidery thread

-safety eyes (any size)

## Wings - make 2 Main body MR:6sts[6] Using white yarn sc in each st [12] MR:6sts<sup>[6]</sup> hdc inc in each st [12] (2sc, sc) x6 [18] $(2sc, sc2) \times 6[24]$ (dc inc, dc) x6 [18] (2sc, sc3) x6 [30]hdc in each st [18] (2sc, sc4) x6 [36]Join with ss and cut yarn leaving long end to sew to body. sc in each st [36] Sew wings to the middle of the yellow stripe sc in each st [36]

Attach safety eyes, embroider face and change to black yarn

Cut yarn and run end around the outside loops of last 6 stitches and weave in end.
