

# Donut Bun Instructions

Hair straight back (**no part**) and secure.

Be sure to use gel / hairspray on entire bun. Use extra bobby pins on the wrap around.

**You will need:**

- One hair donut
- Two hair ties (the color of your child's hair)
- A comb and brush
- Bobby pins (if you have long or thick hair be sure to use the big bobby pins)
- Hair Spray and Hair Gel

## HOW TO MAKE A DONUT BUN

1. Put hair in a very neat high ponytail

High Ponytail: when you are looking straight in the mirror you should only see a small amount of the hair from the ponytail **\*\*NOT on top of your head\*\***

2. Thread your ponytail hair through the donut

3. Smooth your hair over the hair donut, distributing your hair evenly

4. Put a second hair band over the hair donut

5. Wrap hair around bun - Pinning the extra hair down around the bun.

Spray Hair to ensure secure.

If needed use gel and spray to hold back any fly-a-ways
