

**TOWN OF RED SPRINGS BOARD MEETING MINUTES**  
**July 8, 2026**

1. Chairman Lonnie Schreiber called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. and led the Pledge of Allegiance. Also present were Supervisors Jennifer Morris and Gary Olsen, Treasurer Jackie Schmidt and Clerk Gwen Olsen.

3. Jennifer Morris moved to approve the agenda, and Gary Olsen seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

4. There were no public comments on the agenda items.

5. The Board reviewed the meeting minutes of June 10, 2026. Gary Olsen moved to approve them, and Jennifer Morris seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

6. The Board reviewed the financial report. Jennifer Morris moved to pay all outstanding bills, and Gary Olsen seconded. Motion carried unanimously.

7. Letters of resignation were received from the Elected Clerk and Treasurer. Motion by Gary Olsen, second by Jennifer Morris to accept the resignations, Motion carried unanimously.

8. Motion by Jennifer Morris, second by Gary Olsen, to appoint Jackie Schmidt as the Town Treasurer with a term ending July 31, 2030, and a salary of \$8,500 annually, and when she works the polls to be paid as a poll worker, motion carried unanimously. Motion by Jennifer Morris, second by Lonnie Schreiber to appoint Gwen Olsen as the Town Clerk with a term ending July 31, 2030, and a salary of \$14,000 annually and when she works the polls to be paid as a poll worker, motion carried with Gary Olsen abstaining from the vote.

9.: The Assessor's Agreement from Action Appraisers for 2027-2030 was reviewed. Motion by Gary Olsen to approve the new Assessor's agreement, and Jennifer Morris seconded. Motion carried unanimously. This agreement will include an exterior revaluation and maintenance for 2028.

10. Update on Town Roads was given. The first mowing was completed. Chip sealing will happen on North Schmidt Lane and Litzen Drive, Paving will happen on North Schmidt Lane, part of Huntington Road, and Island Lake Lane.

11. Items for next month's meeting:

12. A question was asked about if the Town was interested in selling the park property the Town owns around Beaulieu Lake. The Town is not interested in selling any property currently.

13. Gary Olsen moved to adjourn the Town Board meeting at 7:45 p.m., and Jennifer Morris seconded. Motion carried unanimously, and the meeting adjourned.
