- All follow ARBA S.O.P. (Standard of Perfection) as well.
- Note* NO VM, Magpies or Harlequins of any sort are listed.
- Always check weights, eye color, and type.
- Look at pedigrees! Understand, have knowledge of what you need to look for and are acquiring.
