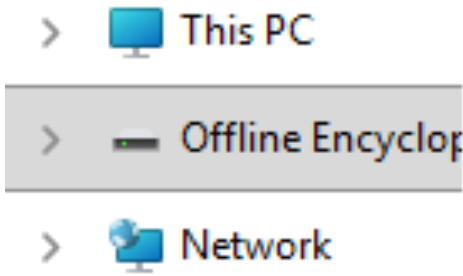
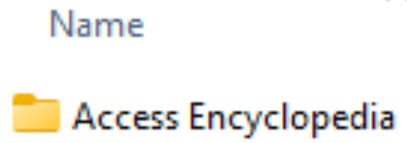


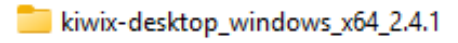
1. Plug in USB to your computer and find the name of your drive in file explorer.



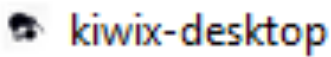
2. In your drive, (the example here is called offline encyclopedia) double click "Access Encyclopedia."

4. Scroll down until you find the app shown below. This is the software used to read the offline encyclopedia.



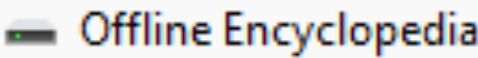
5. In the left hand side of the app, click "Local files."

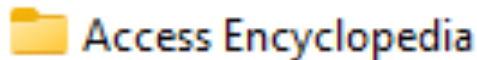
6. In the upper right of the Kiwix app, click the folder icon. This will open the file explorer again.



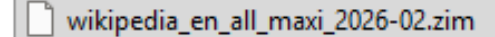
7. In the window that just opened, double click "Offline Encyclopedia" again.



8. Double click the name of your drive.



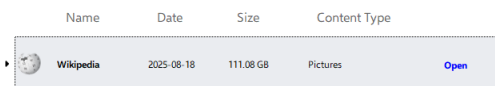
Double click the item showed below. This is where Kiwix will read the encyclopedia from.



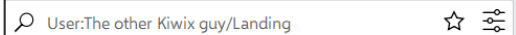
Double click the link to open Wikipedia.
