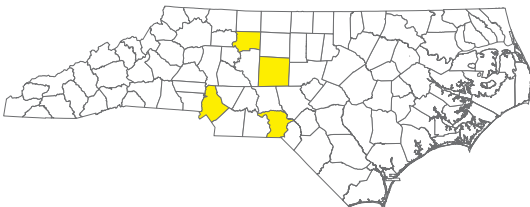

Behavioral Health Urgent Care Services:

Behavioral Health Urgent Care provides an alternative to Emergency Room and Inpatient Psychiatric Hospitalization for individuals who have a mental illness and/or substance use disorder.

Each unit is staffed by licensed clinicians, qualified professionals and peer support staff. Patients can stay up to 23 hours for observation, further assessment and care management.

Behavioral Health Urgent Care units are open 24/7/365. No appointment is necessary and a person can walk in if they are experiencing a crisis or need intervention to prevent a crisis.

Therapeutic interventions are provided to help an individual remain in the community, reduce symptoms and risk of harm.
