Please supply a brief statement describing the emergency necessitating the request.)	<p>The situation in the country that is currently happening is a great sorrow for every Ukrainian. Having traveled all over Ukraine, we saw that a huge number of people needed and complained about their poverty. Most people were forced to leave the ATO zone, where fighting is currently taking place. There they saw all the fear and terror of war. Running away from the "trouble" that forced them to move to a safer place, they still do not intend to leave their country - considering themselves to be Ukrainians. Fortunately, they were sheltered by families, sanatoriums and many institutions that are not indifferent to the grief of others. Together we help them in rehabilitation and normal life in our land. They all need work, clothing, hygiene and medicine.</p> <p>Since conflict in eastern Ukraine has started we have over a million-displaced people, that includes children that lost their parents, elder that lost their life supported families and disabled people. With all that our financial situation is at its worse, but government still constantly lowering social assistance. For this very reason, the entire burden of assistance to pensioners, single-parents and children who were orphaned was left to volunteer NGO organizations, because the state simply cannot provide them with necessary life support.</p>

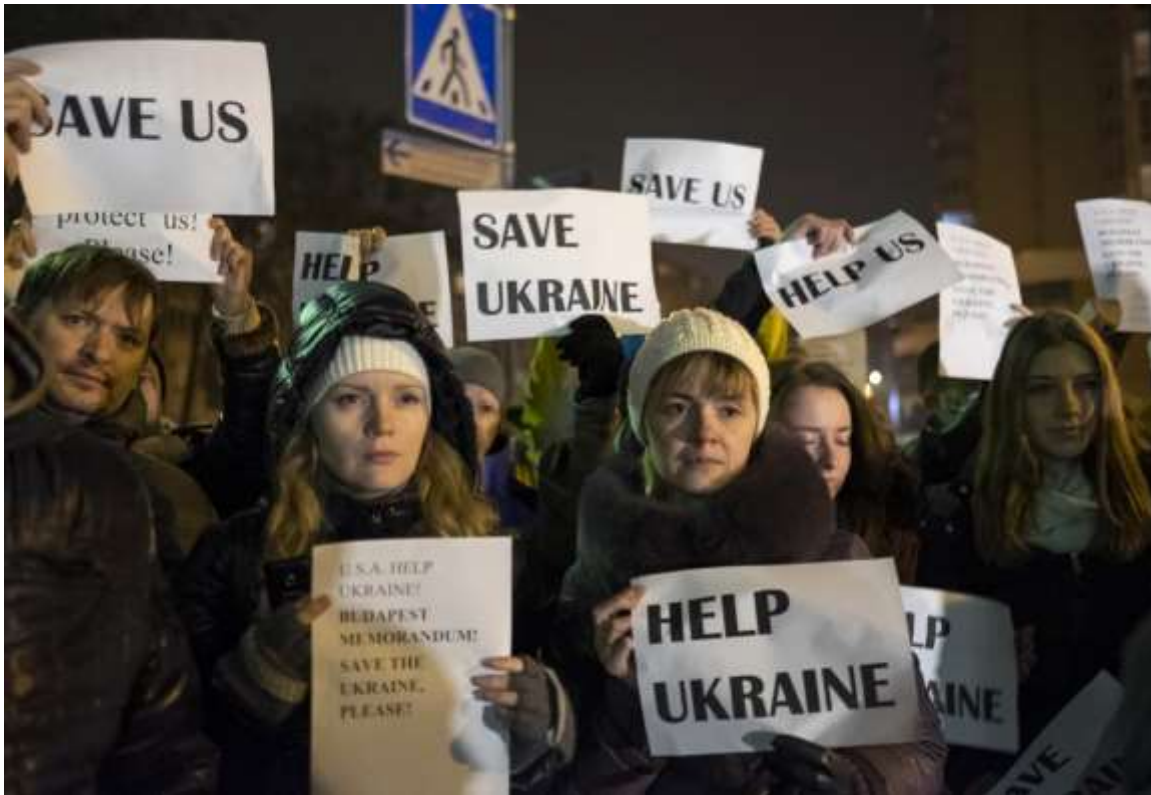
