Taking into account the statement on the actual seizure of power by the Army on April 3, 1985;
Taking into account the proclamation of the 2nd Republic;
Taking into account Decree No.329 / PRG as of December 18, 1984 on the reorganization of the Government of the 2nd Republic;
Taking into account Decree No. 009 / PRG as of April 18, 1984 extending the validity of the valid Laws and Regulations as of 03.04.84;
Taking into account the Statute A.G.B.E.F.;

Resolved:

Article 1. In the Republic of Guinea, was established the Association called " Association of Guinea for Welfare in the Family" (A.G.B.E.F.), whose activities are regulated by Decree No. 516/MTAS/CAB/05/85 as of May 11, 1985.

Article 2. – The goal of this association is to maintain balance and contribute to the harmony of the family.

To do this, it offers:

- a) To participate in the quality improvement of the lives of the population of Guinea (in its structure, psychological-emotional, economic and socio-cultural issues), encouraging parents to recognize their responsibility for all problems relating to fertility (fertility and sterility), child upbringing and family support .
- b) To create appropriate conditions for maintaining the physical, mental and social health of the family, urging parents to make breaks between children.
- c) To assist sterile couples and provide counseling to improve their conditions.
- d) To inform the public about methods of family planning and education in family life.
- e) To promote the conditions necessary to protect the rights of mothers and the protection of the rights of the child.

Article 3. This Association is non-profit and apolitical.

Article 4. This resolution will be recorded and published in the Official Newspaper of the Republic.

<p>Guinea is one of the poorest countries in the world with the population that has undergone a lot of political turmoil. Most of the population lives in extreme poverty. Per capita GDP barely exceeds 50USD.</p> <p>Due to the refugee crisis and with the only possibility to find work in the larger cities, the population in these cities, including the capital Conakry, has overgrown beyond reasonable conditions. This situation is causing serious problems: the infrastructure is missing; roads are dilapidated; public transportation is in a dire state. Sanitary and social infrastructures are poor or non-existent. Education for underprivileged is absent.</p> <p>With the advance of the Ebola epidemic that has swept the country and moved it into chaos, left us with no city in the country that was not affected. Governmental financial support is at its lowest, causing insecurity and leaving the population in a dangerous health situation.</p> <p>All this triggered a huge increase in the population of orphans, refugees, and poor masses that are forgotten. There are not enough food or dwellings, shoes or clothing or other essential necessities for basic living.</p>

Number of persons in each category) Who benefits from the proposed assistance or project?	<p>AGBEF organization covers distribution area that covers 25 different orphan homes, as well as multiple refugee camps with children and families.</p> <p>In this project, we are looking to supply clothes and shoes for our members. According to our distribution plan, this project will clothe parentless children and about 4000 refugee families.</p>
PROJECT GOAL (In brief, describe the goal of the project and intended impact of the material aid requested.)	Our project aims to improve quality of life for our people in Guinea. While the economic position of our country is not allowing masses to rise and reach the rest of the world, with the help of our donors we will be able to dress people and, thus, give them a chance to improve their life conditions.

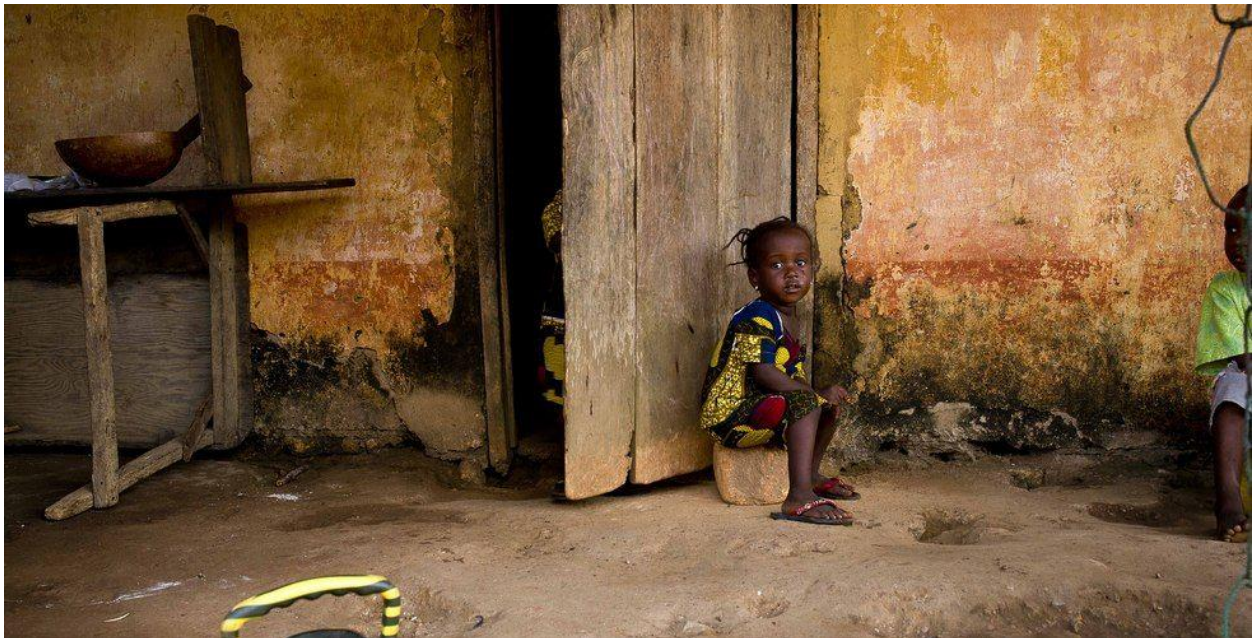
