<text><text><text><text></text></text></text></text>	Our containers target the most vulnerable recipients located in social housings, asylums, and shelters throughout Georgia. Our beneficiaries include homeless people, disabled, IDPs and other socially-vulnerable families and individuals below the poverty line. The need for clothing, footwear, and toys is very high during this cold winter for these vulnerable people. As you consider the current economic crisis here (devaluation of local currency, inflation, unemployment) your assistance to our vulnerable people is very timely and has vital importance. The shipping of supplies is important from another perspective that is critical to our people—it shows a wonderful kindness, and it shows our recipients that someone cares about them. For our homeless beneficiaries, who have lost hope and have a moral breakdown it is very important to give them food and clothing, so they see smiles on faces of their family members even for few hours or few days. Whenever containers are distributed the recipients rush to see families and relatives, and they carry donated humanitarian items with them to share with their family members. It is like these containers give them a wonderful Christmas-like holiday! With your support we can bring happiness to hundreds of families, located at the municipal Shelters, Asylums, to thousands of Internally Displaced (IDP) people from 2008 war with Russia who have no stability in life, to hundreds of single mothers and their children who struggle just to survive in poverty, to socially, vulnerable people with disabilities and with mothers who have children with disabilities. These groups number in the thousands and face life's traumas all alone—ONLY YOU give them help and hope!

Once the received HA commodities are stored at the warehouse, we will conduct an actual inventory count: one person will count, the second will record it, and the third will supervise to make sure the process is correct and transparent. Actual inventory will be compared to packing list and in case of discrepancy - the discrepancy letter (report) will be sent to the donor. Commodities will be stored at the warehouse, sealed and locked. While unloading containers commodities will be counted. Distributions will be recorded. We will collect Thank-You Letters, Photos, Impact Stories and other Feedback reports from our beneficiaries, NGOs and local government.
