**Story 1** We received a lot of words of thanks addressed to American donors while distributing dry food mixes and peanut butter to war (ATO) veterans that live in the freed parts of the Donetsk Region. The UN and International Red Cross have almost shut down their humanitarian operations in the Donetsk Region.
