BENEFICIARY STORIES (can be attached on a separate page)

Story 1 (*file name or wright story below*) In November 2019 we participated in the first graduation ceremony for a class of first graders in the mountain village of Samarguela, Copan, Honduras. This village is remote with no running water or any public facilities. Children were being schooled in a villagers' home which he had graciously allowed them to meet in. After the ceremony we provided the mothers and grandmothers of the village with donation bags containing the rice and corn as well as juice packets and cookies.





Story 2 (file name or wright story below) Nueva Esperanza is a new village near our school which was built upon a former municipal dump. The village is comprised of about 50 homes (1-2 room brick structures) and in partnership with the villagers we have helped them to build a church, an elementary school, installed water purification systems and provide them with medical brigades.

We distributed the food supplies to the

women of the village to relieve the hardships they suffer due to lack of employment and poverty.



Story 3 (*file name or wright story below*) Plan Escalon is a boarding Middle/High School for at risk students in La Entrada, Copan, Honduras. Typical enrollment ranges from 150-350 students annually. Children receive 3 meals daily, dorm housing, a Christian environment, a state sanctioned educational curriculum, technical and vocational training. We are/will continue to use the rice and corn to feed the students here at the school.
