The families in this part of the country, Konongo/Odumasi metropolitan area are farmers and have enough to feed themselves but lack the means to give any proper education to children or child care. Most of the parents are not educated and are anxious to have their children receive basic education. Due to lack of governmental assistance most of young children as young as 18 months are without hope for the future and in constant danger. The school children ages 18 months to 14 years come from poor and disadvantaged families who are mostly farmers and street hawkers. The children mostly roam the streets because the parents are not able to send them to school

Number of persons in each category) Who benefits from the proposed assistance or project?	Our school is targeting to assist indigent children from low income families with food, education and Child care. At this time, we already providing services to 500 children at our boarding school. Our beneficiaries are from 18 months old to 14 years of age. A lot of them are hungry and have no clothes to ware, as well as totally cut off from progress of the rest of the world.
