Single Parents/ Widows with young Children: CAIDSPAGNO with donor support intends to help widows with small microcredit for farming in rural communities. After harvest, they repay the farming credit so that we can extend the credit to other vulnerable groups in the rural communities. For those women who are in cities and are interested in doing business, we loan them certain amount which they have to repay. The money they repay, we can use it to help other vulnerable women. 2. Orphans, youth and Children: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> A) For the orphans, we need to provide shelter for them, cloth them and build for them
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schools closer to the orphanage for effective monitoring of their progress.

B) For the Youths, we want to help them in building up their skills through Carpentry Workshop (Wood Processing Factory) and Welding Workshop: Here, they will be able to learn how to make various furniture, metal Doors, windows and gates. They will be able to learn some skills while also earning some money for living.

C) For Children, we wish to build primary and Secondary schools where they could be educated for their future.
