<p>The Gambia which borders Senegal on all fronts except on the Atlantic Ocean. We aim to promote quality education, health and the provision of Clothing for orphans, and the elderly. Therefore, we are urgently necessitating our request. If this request is successful it will go a long way to impact on the lives of the people of both The Gambia and Senegal. These vulnerable people are going through a lot of hardships. Since death rates are higher in both countries, many orphans are also left behind. It is true that the region needs much help to equip its left residence with quality education and educate them. As education is the key to the development of any nation, it is a necessity for these orphans gets quality education.</p> <p>Banjul is a cosmopolitan city situated in the St. Mary's island at the southern part of the river Gambia an estuary in the republic of The Gambia. It is about 30km from Municipal Council and has a land surface area of 12 sq. km. The whole population of Banjul is 31,301. At the Southern part of the river Gambia an estuary (Banjul) comprises of more than seven tribes Akus, Sereres, Fulas, Manjagos, Wollofs, Jolas and Mandinkas etc.</p> <p>The Gambia as a third developing country in the world its population is 2,223703 million people and haave seven administrative regions, in a year we have 12,810 deaths and in one day it is between 31 to 35 or more deaths. These deaths is as result of the lack of the requisite medications to tackle diseases such as Malaria, Small pox, diebetes and TB etc. There is also the ask of patients dying from minor surgeries due to the lack of proper equipment to carry out such surgeries. It is in the view of this that Mothers Club organisation is soliciting assistance in the form of medical equipment to equip health facilities we have but are lacking these equipment. In each of these regions there are major health Centers but lack of equipment and medication to carry out delicate operations, has in most cases resulted in lose of lives during and after surgery. With your help and intervention, we cannot drastically reduce the death rate in the country, but we can put a big dent in it.</p> <p>Poor health and short life expectancy among the residence in the regions is a direct result of poor education and poor living conditions. The rapid death rates are not only an eye sore but also a change to the area. We as the members of Mothers Club Organization are ready to fight this issue with your support.</p> <p>The provision of furniture will increase enrolment into the schools, thereby helping to drastically reduce the illiteracy rate in the area. It will also help minimize the problem of students trekking long distances to access schools in other areas.</p> <p>The provision of clothing for orphans, aging people (elderly) will also help to improve the quality standards of lives of these orphans and elderly.</p> <p>The provision of visually Impaired equipment will also help to improve the quality of lives of these visually Impaired children. Were most of the visually Impaired children parents preferred to educate the "Normal" child, than the</p>

Among the totals of these villages and Towns it includes 1,600 disabled, visually Impaired children 1,500 and 1,800 elderly peoples.</p>
