The health facilities in this catchment area are in deplorable conditions due to the lack of basic hospital equipment in the maternity, pediatric and admission wards, surgical ward, surgical equipment, ophthalmological equipment, dentistry equipment, and ambulatory equipment.
	Elementary schools in the are also lack basic logistics such as desk, school supplies, basic science equipment to reinforce effective learning.
TARGETED BENEFICIARIES (approx. Number of persons living there, main categories of persons in need and approx. Number of persons in each category) Who benefits from the proposed assistance or project?	The Nsawam/Adoagyiri Municipal Assembly has a population of 55,522. The economy of the area is predominantly petty trading and share cropping. About 1/3 of this population have received some formal education and nearly 8/10 of the population are below the poverty level. Thus, education and healthcare cannot be afforded by the residents of this area.
PROJECT GOAL (In brief, describe the goal of the project and intended impact of the material aid requested.)	The ultimate goal of Help Motherland Ghana is to reach the poorest and sickest in deplorable conditions in the Nsawam/Adoagyiri Municipal Assembly who cannot afford basic educational and health care services. Expectant mothers in labor sleeping on floors, new born babies sleeping on floors and on plastic chairs are just few among the myriads of deplorable conditions in these areas. HMG aims at equipping schools and health centers with basic equipment and supplies to promote educational and healthcare services and thus bring relief and comfort to students and patients (adults, children and babies).


