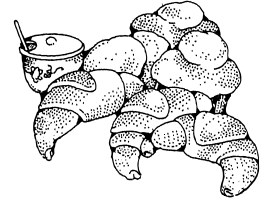
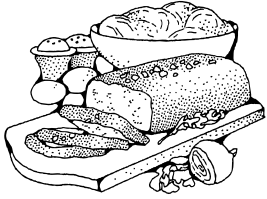

BARB'S BAKED CHICKEN W/ BACON & WILD RICE



INGREDIENTS

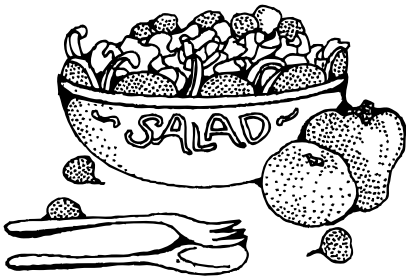
- One 12-oz package Thick-Cut Peppered Bacon
- ½ White Onion, thinly sliced
- 6 Tbsp Salted Butter
- Three 6.2 oz boxes Uncle Ben's Long Grain & Wild Rice Fast Cook (cooked according to package directions)
- One 10.5 oz can Condensed Cream of Onion or Cream of Mushroom Soup
- 1 cup Sour Cream
- 1 cup Chicken Broth
- 1 tsp Garlic Powder
- Kosher Salt & Ground Pepper
- 2 ½ pounds Chicken Tenders
- ¼ cup chopped Chives or Parsley for garnish

DIRECTIONS

1. Preheat oven to 375 degrees
2. Lay bacon slices side by side to cover the bottom of a 9 x 13 x 3-inch deep baking pan or other wide, deep baking dish. Use any remaining slices along the sides of the pan. Place onion slices on top of the bacon, overlapping them as necessary to cover the bottom. Cut 4 tablespoons of butter into cubes and evenly sprinkle them on top of the onions.
3. In a large bowl, combine the wild rice blend, soup, sour cream, broth, garlic powder and salt and pepper to taste. Stir until combined. Spoon the rice over the butter cubes and smooth the mixture out. Nestle the tenders into the rice, pressing them down slightly. Melt the remaining 2 tablespoons butter and brush it on the chicken. Season with a few pinches of salt and pepper.
4. Cover the pan tightly with foil and bake for 55 minutes. Uncover and bake until the chicken is cooked through, about 20 minutes.
5. Sprinkle the chives or parsley on top. Serve right out of the pan.
6. Store leftovers in a covered container in the refrigerator for up to 4 days.
