



1 Tbsp olive oil

• 1 small onion, finely chopped

2 stalks celery, finely chopped

2 cloves garlic, minced

• 1 can (15 oz) crushed tomatoes

1 can (15 oz) tomato sauce

• 2 cans (14 oz ea) beef broth

• ½ Tbsp Italian herbs

- INGREDIENTS -

• ½ tsp each salt & pepper

• 1 pkg (12 oz) precooked, refrigerated Italian-style meatballs

 ½ pkg (5 oz) frozen cut leaf spinach, thawed, squeezed dry and chopped

• 1 pkg (19 oz) refrigerated or frozen cheese tortellini

Parmesan cheese

DIRECTIONS -


- 1. Heat olive oil in a large pot over medium-high heat. Saute onion, celery, and garlic until softened, about 3 minutes.
- 2.Add crushed tomatoes, tomato sauce, broth, herbs, salt, pepper, meatballs, and spinach to the pot; stir to combine. Bring to a boil, then lower heat and simmer for 5 minutes.

3. Stir in tortellini; cook for an additional 3-5 minutes.

4. If thinner consistency is desired, add water or more beef broth in small increments.

5. Garnish with parmesan cheese.
