Best Bingo Bites QUICK & EASY MEATBALL TORTELLINI SOUP

Recipie Submitted by a Visiting Brother Darby Davies



INGREDIENTS

- 1 Tbsp olive oil
- 1 small onion, finely chopped
- 2 stalks celery, finely chopped
- 2 cloves garlic, minced
- 1 can (15 oz) crushed tomatoes
- 1 can (15 oz) tomato sauce
- 2 cans (14 oz ea) beef broth
- ½ Tbsp Italian herbs
- ½ tsp each salt & pepper
- 1 pkg (12 oz) precooked, refrigerated Italian-style meatballs
- ½ pkg (5 oz) frozen cut leaf spinach, thawed, squeezed dry and chopped
- 1 pkg (19 oz) refrigerated or frozen cheese tortellini
- Parmesan cheese

DIRECTIONS

1. Heat olive oil in a large pot over medium-high heat. Saute onion, celery, and garlic until softened, about 3 minutes.
2. Add crushed tomatoes, tomato sauce, broth, herbs, salt, pepper, meatballs, and spinach to the pot; stir to combine. Bring to a boil, then lower heat and simmer for 5 minutes.
3. Stir in tortellini; cook for an additional 3-5 minutes.
4. If thinner consistency is desired, add water or more beef broth in small increments.
5. Garnish with parmesan cheese.

- Proposition for membership 1st Read: 3 Applicants.
- 2nd Read and Balloting: 4 Initiates
- Report from interview committee: All found favorable
- Initiated: 4 Initiates.
- Report of sick & visiting committee: Claire Fagen surgery went well. Doug Phelan is also doing well.
