

**ELK CREEK TOWNSHIP SUPERVISORS**  
**Minutes**  
**September 4, 2018**

**Call to Order:** A regular meeting was called to order at 7:32 pm by Chairman, William Taylor, as previously advertised, and took place at the Elk Creek Township building. The Pledge of Allegiance followed.

**Roll Call:** Members present were Supervisors William Taylor, Robert Soltis and Michael Hill, as well as, Erin Anderson, Township Secretary/Treasurer. There were several public attendants, including Dave Stearns, Daniel Kulik and Debbie and Mike Orr.

**Public Comment:** Dust control on West Road was discussed. Supervisor Soltis advised that it is too late in the year to place brine. Chairman Taylor informed of the Township's intent to further research soybean oil as a dust deterrent.

**Reports:**

Public Works – Road maintenance with the tar buggy will occur soon. Mowing for 2018 is almost complete.

Elk Creek Planning – No August meeting was held as there was no quorum. Next meeting 09/25 at 7:30pm.

**Minutes:** The August 6, 2018 minutes were motioned for approval by Robert Soltis, seconded by Michael Hill. Roll call vote. All in favor. Motion carried.

**Financial Report:** The financial report was handed out with the agenda. Robert Soltis made a motion to pay the bills as presented and to accept the financial report with an amendment to the PLGIT savings account receipts. The motion was seconded by Michael Hill. Roll call vote. All in favor. Motion carried.

The 2019 Minimum Municipal Obligation (MMO) for the Township was presented. The pension amounts paid by the Township for full time employees will remain the same as 2018.

The Board agreed to spec out a new snowplow truck for 2019.

A letter of intent to serve on the Elk Creek Township Planning Commission by John A. Moyak was presented to the Board. Robert Soltis made a motion to appoint Mr. Moyak as a member and was seconded by Michael Hill. All Board Supervisors agreed to appoint John A Moyak to the Elk Creek Township Planning Commission.
