Minutes
August 6, 2018

Call to Order: A regular meeting was called to order at 7:30 pm by Chairman, William Taylor, as previously advertised, and took place at the Elk Creek Township building. The Pledge of Allegiance followed.

Roll Call: Members present were Supervisors William Taylor, Robert Soltis and Michael Hill, as well as, Erin Anderson, Township Secretary/Treasurer. There were several public attendants, including John Moyak, Sue Shaffer, Mary Monnhain, Dave Stearns, Jim Reiser and Debbie and Mike Orr.

Public Comment: West Road new seal coat was discussed. There was confusion as to how many layers were placed. Dirt to tar and chip is three layers (oil,tar,chips), not three layers of tar and chip. Soybean oil was also mentioned and explained for possible future use by the township.
