### OVERSEAS TEACHING OPPORTUNITY

*Connect to Canada International* represents many education groups in mainland China. These education groups, located in a variety of large cities in eastern China, require teachers to support student success in their International Education programs – both elementary and secondary.

At the elementary level, general studies teachers are required to provide instruction in English to Chinese students, many of whom will visit Canada for one term or more. At the secondary level, a variety of teaching specialists is required (ESL, Mathematics, Science, etc.). Students complete up to Grade 10 in China and then complete Grade 11 and 12 in Ontario secondary schools. *Connect to Canada International* partners with several large GTA school boards, including the Peel DSB, Dufferin-Peel DSB, Halton DSB and others to place students in Ontario schools on their arrival in Canada.

*Connect to Canada International* is hiring teachers to a pool. These teachers will be deployed to cities and school boards as required in cities such as Wuhan, Suzhou, Hangzhou, Weifang, Shijiazhuang and others to work in various schools. New teachers are highly supported by these schools who greatly value the contributions of “foreign teachers”. You will be assisted with all aspects of your orientation to teaching in China: communicate with local students, logistics of relocating to the school campus, housing, food, etc. The focus of these teaching positions is to help students improve their English language skills using the Ontario curriculum, and to prepare them to study in the GTA. Teachers will be required to provide instruction and assessment in the assigned subject area(s) on a full-time basis for ten (10) months.

There is the possibility of renewal for these positions annually. The expected start date for these positions is September 1, 2018.

The rate of pay is as follows:
