Green Space Policy

Due to abuse and misuse of the Village's Green Space, Council has implemented this policy for green-waste drop-off:

- Examples of **acceptable items** for drop-off include: mown grass, fallen branches, cut branches, hedge trimmings, and spent flowers.
- Examples of **non-acceptable items** for drop-off include, and are not limited to: tires, mattresses, paint, plastics, old drywall, broken windows, any construction debris, empty greenhouse pots and waste from any animal.

- To schedule a Green Space drop-off, please call the Village Maintenance office number, 419-454-6500.
 1. Leave a voice mail message which includes your name, your Village address, and the best phone number to return your call.
 2. A Village employee will return your call and assist you with scheduling a drop-off. Drop-offs may be scheduled during weekdays, evenings, and weekends.

- Who may use the Village's Green Space for green-waste drop-offs?
 1. Village of Bloomdale residents may use the Green Space for green-waste collected from either rented or owned Village property.
 2. Landscapers and tree-trimmers, either incorporated or independent, who have culled green-waste from a Village owned or rented property.

- 3. Who may **not** use the Village's Green Space for green-waste drop-offs?
 1. Landscapers or tree-trimmers, either incorporated or independent, who have culled green-waste from any property outside of the Village's corporation limits.
 2. Residents or contractors, either incorporated or independent, who have culled concrete or asphalt waste from renovated driveways, sidewalks, yard art, and countertops.
