## Green Space Policy

Due to abuse and misuse of the Village's Green Space, Council has implemented this policy for green-waste drop-off:

- Examples of **acceptable items** for drop-off include: mown grass, fallen branches, cut branches, hedge trimmings, and spent flowers.
- Examples of **non-acceptable items** for drop-off include, and are not limited to: tires, mattresses, paint, plastics, old drywall, broken windows, any construction debris, empty greenhouse pots and waste from any animal.
- To schedule a Green Space drop-off, please call the Village Maintenance office number, 419-454-6500.
- 1. Leave a voice mail message which includes your name, your Village address, and the best phone number to return your call.
- 2. A Village employee will return your call and assist you with scheduling a drop-off. Drop-offs may be scheduled during weekdays, evenings, and weekends.
- Who may use the Village's Green Space for green-waste drop-offs?
  - 1. Village of Bloomdale residents may use the Green Space for green-waste collected from either rented or owned Village property.
  - 2. Landscapers and tree-trimmers, either incorporated or independent, who have culled green-waste from a Village owned or rented property.
- 3. Who may **not** use the Village's Green Space for green-waste drop-offs?
  - 1. Landscapers or tree-trimmers, either incorporated or independent, who have culled green-waste from any property outside of the Village's corporation limits.
  - 2. Residents or contractors, either incorporated or independent, who have culled concrete or asphalt waste from renovated driveways, sidewalks, yard art, and countertops.
