

Ordinance 2024-O-05

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE RATES COLLECTED FROM RESIDENTS FOR REFUSE COLLECTION PROVIDED BY NAT TRANSPORTATION, INC. FOR THE VILLAGE OF BLOOMDALE, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Village of Bloomdale Council has determined that it is necessary to adjust the existing refuse rates in order to keep existing infrastructure and services properly running; and,

WHEREAS, the Village Council believes it prudent to develop a five-year plan in order to properly plan for refuse expenses according to the NAT contract June 1, 2024 through June 1, 2028.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF BLOOMDALE, WOOD COUNTY, OHIO:

SECTION 1: REFUSE RATE: Refuse rates are currently \$17.50 per month for Village Residents

SECTION 2: REFUSE RATE: Refuse rates will decrease to \$14.00 per month for Village Residents for the remainder of the year 2024. Refuse rates will increase every year after for Village Residents

Year 2025: \$14.75

Year 2026: \$15.50

Year 2027: \$16.25

Year 2028: \$17.00 until new contract is established in June of 2028

SECTION 3: All sections of prior ordinance in conflict with this rate schedule are hereby repealed, and all other sections of those ordinances shall remain in full force and effect,

SECTION 4: This Ordinance is hereby declared an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of the Village of Bloomdale, Ohio and the further reason that the immediate adoption of this ordinance is necessary to maintain the financial integrity of the Village's Refuse Fund, whereas this ordinance shall be in effect on the earliest date provided by law.
