Designed to be intimate and relaxed, our fine dining roundtables encourage security leaders to freely discuss their challenges, concerns and successes with peers who,

quite simply, get it. It's a unique blend of personal connection and highly valuable insight into real-world business needs.

We work with each vendor to create a compelling guest list with serious breakthrough potential for your business, and agree two focused discussion topics to help make this happen.

An experienced moderator – often our founder, Simon Linstead – keeps the conversation flowing and on point, so the evening feels collegial and productive.

While these events are not about pitching, we get things started with a 10-minute spotlight on the vendor business.

BREAKFAST MEETINGS

OPEN MIC DEBATES



THE CONCEPT

Network, share knowledge, trade opinions and gain an understanding of what key security decision-makers and leaders really think during this dynamic, open-ended experience. Forget static panels – we constantly move mics around the room so everyone can question, answer and interact.

We ensure at least 30 senior IT and security decision makers, and a maximum of just four vendors (or resellers), for major networking impact. The informal, give-and-take format is designed to generate collaborative thinking, a better grasp of others' points of view and, as a result, real engagement.

We work with each vendor to create discussion topics and a guest list from sectors that matter to you, and deliver contact details so you can develop connections. While our debates are about people, not pitching, we provide stands for vendor promotional materials.

Included in the package is exposure to a wider audience with our media and PR outreach package, which includes 12 articles about the event to be published across quality high-traffic websites like Business Insider, HackRead, Tech Startups, Analytics Insights, MSSP Alert and Yahoo Finance, reaching an estimated 522,000 potential viewers.

THE MECHANICS

Open Mic Debates start at 5pm and run to 9pm – although participants have kept the conversation going much longer! We organise and promote the event, confirm the guest list, and provide complimentary wine, beer, and soft drinks, along with sliders.

This is a UK or US event for up to 40 guests with four vendors. We can also create entirely bespoke events, at a cost to be agreed.

THE CONCEPT

Get up close and informal with CEOs and CISOs as they share how they view key market trends and technical challenges.

We ensure at least 10 senior IT, security and business leaders participate, along with one sponsoring vendor (who can partner with a reseller). Two key discussion topics are agreed with vendors, designed specifically to attract exactly the kind of individuals they would love to connect with, but might be unsure how to approach.

An experienced moderator – often our founder, Simon Linstead – ensures the conversation stays fluid and engaging. The event rounds

off with an entertaining competition. While there's no selling, the vendor can spotlight their business for 10 minutes.

The Online Roundtables have grown out of our hugely successful "CISO Experience" livestreams, with more than 130,000 views on YouTube alone. This format creates a powerful virtuous circle for all involved, including sponsoring vendors.

The Infosec.live community of cyber professionals benefits from the wisdom of industry big hitters, while leaders tell us they appreciate the fresh insights and opinions of smart, thoughtful professionals in live chats.
