As her mother's "right hand," Lyndin supports the school through social media, technical coordination, music management, and photography for events. The school hosts two major recitals each year, participates in community parades, and even brings students to Disneyland every other year!

Outside of her many responsibilities, Lyndin enjoys the simple pleasures of life, gardening (especially planting flowers), hiking in the mountains, and spending cherished time with her family. She shares that her greatest role model is her mother, Cristy, whose passion for the Woman's Club and natural ability to connect with others have helped shape Lyndin's own confidence and happiness.

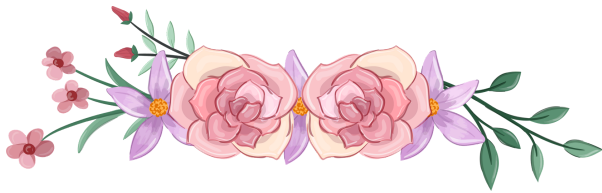
