PROFILE OF JAMES WARRAND





James has been a keen sailor since he grew up on the Pittwater sailing VJ's, and then owned a small yacht in Sydney Harbour for many years.

His working life included being a dairy farmer and contractor, also as a life insurance and general fire insurance agent, marketing of insurance funding companies and as a financial

planner. He has been a volunteer guide at the Maritime Museum for fourteen years, and since 2017 has been part of the Speakers Group (historical and maritime topics).

James also serves as the Enquiry Desk for the HMS Hood Association as his father, Commander John Warrand, was the Squadron Navigation Officer at the time of her sinking in 1941.

James was involved with the Cobbitty Rural Fire Brigade for over 35 years and has been involved with several organisations based in the Camden District.

James has been a volunteer guide at the ANMM for many years and since 2017 has been part of the Speakers Group.


