

# Pilot Information

- Music City Warbirds and Classics is an AMA sanctioned event, all persons wishing to fly must be AMA members. However, a pilot's flight line assistants or spotter are not required to be AMA members.
- All pilots must complete their event registration by signing the AMA Flight Safety Declaration, and as needed Turbine Waiver validation, and/or Large Model Permit to Fly Validation form.
- All pilots will receive a pin-on name badge to wear during the Event. Special aircraft validations will be noted on the badge.
- All pilots/assistants must complete a safety briefing and be issued a wristband to access the flight line.
- Spotters are REQUIRED. If you do not have a spotter, Coffee Airfoilers will have members standing by who will be happy to spot for you.
- Only 2.4 Ghz. radio systems will be permitted, to ensure no radio interference and enhance everyone's flying experience
- A large enclosed storage tent will be provided for overnight storage of your aircraft.
- A Saturday morning Pilot's breakfast will be served. Additional breakfast tickets will be available at registration for \$10 ea.
  
- AIRCRAFT: Monoplanes - 80" wingspan, or true 1/4 scale  
Biplanes - 60" wingspan, or true 1/4 scale  
Jets - (turbine or electric) 140" combined length + wingspan, or true 1/4 scale.  
Must be finished in an authentic scale scheme, this includes military aircraft converted to civilian use in an authentic scheme.  
"Classic" is defined as a civilian aircraft 50 years or more old.
  
- Camping will be allowed along the flight line, at the noted set back. Coffee Airfoilers' field does not have hook-ups.
- Friendly Pets are welcome! Please use appropriate potty clean-up equipment.
