

Pilot Information

- Music City Warbirds and Classics is an AMA sanctioned event, all persons wishing to fly must be AMA members and abide by the event's safety rules.
- All pilots must complete their event registration AT THE EVENT by signing all the AMA forms that apply to them and their models.
- All pilots/spotters must complete a safety briefing and be issued a wristband to access the flight line.
- RADIOS: Only 2.4 Ghz. radio systems will be permitted.
- STORAGE: A large tent will be provided for overnight storage of your aircraft.
- FOOD: A Friday evening Pilot's dinner will be served. ***This year will be Southern Style! "Crazy Daisies"*** truck will be on site for lunch
- AIRCRAFT: Must be giant scale (see flyer above) and must have been test flown and trimmed prior to flying at this event.
- CAMPING: will be allowed along the flight line, at the noted set back. Coffee Airfoilers' field does not have hook-ups.
- LODGING: **There are several hotels in Tullahoma, and even more in Manchester that are very reasonably priced**
- PETS: friendly pets are welcome at the field! Please use appropriate potty clean-up equipment.
