

# Airfoiler Meeting Minutes

## July 2020

The July meeting of the Coffee Airfoilers was held at the club field on July 13th 2020. At 7:00 pm, club president Don Cleveland called the meeting to order. There were 18 of 126 current members present.

**Financial Report.** Club Treasurer Kelly Crawford detailed the club's spending and income. **Public Affairs.** Ken Herrick reported that on Saturday July 25th, he will be assisting at the Hands On Science Center with a rocket launch from 9am until 3pm and therefore will not be attending the Warbird Fun-Fly.

**Flight Training:** Paul Green reported that several Saturday flight training sessions have been busy, but due to the current health concerns there have also been several Saturday sessions when there were no flight training students. Ken Herrick stated that he has not had anyone come to the weekday sessions. Don Cleveland suggested we attempt to get information on our flight training to the C.A.P. and the Boy Scouts. Ken stated he would work on that suggestion.
