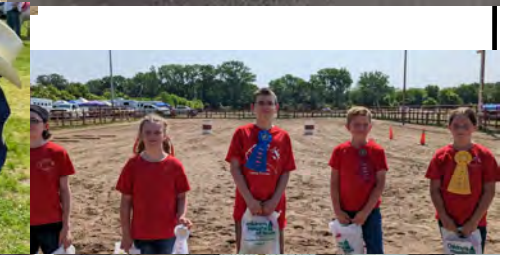

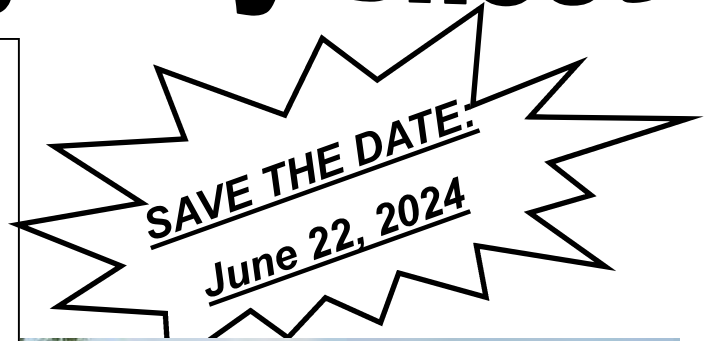

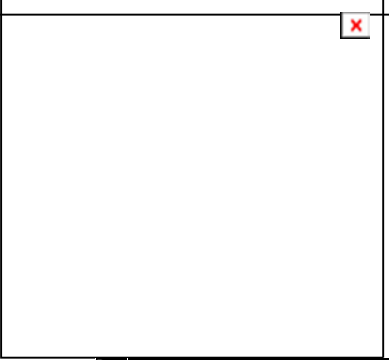
Volunteers were recruited. Riders had practiced. Horses and tack were loaded for the YCHS at the Illinois State Fair Grounds.
