Dumukwa Safaris is situated on the most northern border of South Africa's Limpopo Province and offers you more than 200000 acres of prime hunting ground. You will be able to stalk an abundance of 52 different game species with highly trained hunting professionals.

South Africa's northernmost province, Limpopo, borders onto Mozambique, Zimbabwe and Botswana, making it the ideal entrance to Africa. Named after the great Limpopo River that flows along its northern border, this province is rich in wildlife, spectacular scenery and a wealth of historical and cultural treasures.

The Story of Dumukwa

Our lodge is built on the banks of the Limpopo River with plenty of Waterbuck to see in the Riverine bush. This majestic animal was the inspiration for our name which in Swahili is called a Dumukwa.

Nestled underneath a grove of towering shade trees on the edge of the majestic Limpopo river.



Accommodation

Nestling in the shade of indigenous riverine trees on the banks of the majestic Limpopo River lays our thatched oasis, Dumukwa Lodge. Our unique lodge is built from natural, native materials, to compliment the lush jungle like surroundings. We embrace a casual, family-style atmosphere with an emphasis on informal, relaxed outdoor living and offer luxury accommodation for family, friends, or small groups. Up to 14 guests can be accommodated in 7 luxury thatched roof chalets, decorated in contemporary African design, complete with luxury furnishings that create an elegance that contrasts perfectly with the rugged African bush.



Accommodation

All rooms are airconditioned and have a full bathroom en-suite, with powerful showers where you can relax and enjoy the warm, clean and safe-to-drink water. The dining area which is central to the main lodge, is decorated with local African art. Here you will be served tea, coffee, juice and a hearty breakfast, which will provide needed energy for exciting days in the wild Bushveld. The lounge walks out onto a spacious wooden deck with a spectacular view of the Limpopo river. The lodge and deck locations have been carefully chosen to overlook the natural gathering areas of local wildlife.



Accommodation

It is not uncommon to have elephants, hippos, crocodiles, and an assortment of monkeys and plains game within view as you enjoy a steaming morning coffee, tea or hot chocolate or savour sundowners while relaxing on wooden sofa chairs.

After a sumptuous dinner, adapted to your personal requirements and prepared by our two in-house chefs, the fire place on the wooden deck is a social focal point. A perfect place to reflect on the day's events and retell personal experiences. Here you can enjoy the tantalizing night sounds of the river's many animals while enjoying fine local wines, beer or other liquid refreshments.

Information

Rifles and Ammunition

Before departure, all weapons must be declared at U.S. Customs. The document issued along with the Saps 520 and an invitational letter from us will be needed to bring your weapons into South Africa. The law governing international flights demands that rifles and ammunition be transported in separate lockable cases. After claiming your luggage on arrival, you will go to the South African police service office where you can claim your weapons.

Your rifles will be inspected and an import permit for the duration of your stay will be issued. We can also assist you in obtaining your weapon import permit ahead of your safari. This is highly recommended and will save you a lot of time going through customs. Recommended caliber for plains game hunts is among the 30-caliber class. (338, 300, 30.06, 375 or 7mm). 60 rounds of soft nose ammunition will be sufficient. Required caliber for big game is a minimum of 375. 40 rounds soft nose and 40 rounds of solids are required. Recommended bullets are Barnes X, Trophy Bonded Bear Claw or Swift a-Frame.

Bowhunting

The best time to book your safari will be from the end of April until the end of October. Recommended Broadheads are Muzzies,

Thunderheads and Rocky Mountain Titanium with a weight of approximately 100-125 grain. Shafts should be carbon-aluminium or carbon aluminium composite. For dangerous game, two blade broadheads are recommended with a minimum of an 80-pound bow. Average shots are from 15 to 40 yards from strategically placed blinds or on foot.

Hunting season

The prime hunting period is from April to the end of October. Temperatures in autumn and spring months (Apr. May. Sept. Oct.) will range from 60 f to 90 f and cool down between 40 f to 60 f during winter (Jun. Jul. Aug.) Animals are in rut late May, June and early July.

Travelling

Direct flights on South African Airways depart daily from JFK New York or Dulles airport. Flights are also available on Delta Airlines which depart from Atlanta airport. Flight duration is about 14 – 18 hours. A valid passport is needed to enter South Africa. An additional flight needs to be taken from Johannesburg international to Polokwane airport where Dumukwa Safaris staff will meet you.

Health

No vaccination is required, but anti-malaria prophylaxis is recommended. See your local CDC for up to date information.

Kruger Nat. Park

This park, the biggest in South Africa, is one of the largest repositories of bird and animal life in the world. President Paul Kruger decided, on 28 March 1898, to create a sanctuary for fauna & flora in the form of Sabie game reserve. 1926 saw expansion as far as the Limpopo river, with the park, now covering nearly 2 million hectares and eventually being named Kruger National Park. It is a premier local and international game park, featuring over 250 000 mammalian inhabitants falling into 147 species including all of the "Big 5" : 300 black rhino, 2500 white rhino, 8000 elephant, 900 leopard, 15000 buffalo and 2000 lion, as well as 507 bird, 336 tree, 49 fish, 34 amphibian and 114 reptile species.
