

# JUGANDO Quick Start Installation

## Tools and Safety Equipment

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## Interlocking Tube System

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Interlocking tubes are made from black polyethylene. Each tile requires four (4) Interlocking Tubes.</li> <li>• Interlocking tubes should be installed in the same direction as the longest part of the installation area.</li> </ul>
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## Installing Over Existing Substrates

<p><b>Surfaces</b></p>	<p>JUGANDO may be installed over a solid sub-surface such as concrete or asphalt, or over a compacted granular sub-surface. Particleboard, chipboard, Masonite, and Luan Plywood are not considered suitable underlayment.</p>
<p><b>Prep</b></p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The sub-surface must be flat/smooth, clean, and dry, structurally sound and all debris including old adhesives must be removed. Scraping may be required to remove debris.</li> <li>• In all cases, proper drainage must be provided due to the porous nature of the tiles. This can be achieved by either a well-defined gradient of the surface or well-placed drainage pipe in lower spots.</li> </ul>

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

## Site Elevation


- On grade installation: The finished installed height of the JUGANDO surface will be equal to or slightly higher than the perimeter grade but not more than 1” higher unless approved by the project engineer.
- Above grade installation: The installation of JUGANDO over existing decks or slabs is referred to as an “above grade installation” and will usually require the use of reducers around the perimeters of the area to transition smooth back to the floor elevation unless the site terminates at a wall or other vertical surface.



- Dry-lay tiles before permanent install

## Create Chalk Lines



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

	<p>Interlocking Tiles (No Adhesive Required):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Installing along a straight edge:<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>○ Place first tile at designated starting point, either against a wall or existing border. Align first row of tiles along a straight edge.</li><li>○ Make sure that all interlocking holes are facing toward unfinished area. (Do not put any interlocking tubes in first row of tiles.)</li><li>○ Interlocking tubes should be installed in the same direction as the longest part of the installation area.</li><li>○ Start second row with a half tile, which is simply a full tile cut in half.</li><li>○ As you are installing each tile, tilt slightly to ease pegs into existing tile.</li><li>○ Tap with mallet ensure tight fit.</li><li>○ Continue installation in staggered method. Repeat first and second row until installation is complete.</li></ul></li></ul>

## ADA Compliance – Ramps, wedges and corner pieces

<p>1.5" WEDGE      INSIDE CORNER      1.5" ADA WHEELCHAIR RAMP</p> <p>2.25" WEDGE      OUTSIDE CORNER      2.25" WHEELCHAIR RAMP</p>	<p>Use JUGANDO rubber ADA ramps and transition wedges for wheelchair accessibility to meet ADA Compliance. Adhere to the edge of the rubber paver tile and/or glue to the sub-surface or transition pieces.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Ensure smooth transitions (no gaps or abrupt changes)</li> <li>• Surface is firm, stable, slip-resistant</li> </ul>
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## Adhesive, Sealer and Maintenance Recommendations

<p><b>Optional Adhesives</b></p>	<p><b>Optional</b> - No adhesive needed for interlocking installs unless extra security required</p> <p><b>Adhesive</b> - Chemrex Urethane 948 (V.O.C. compliant)</p> <p><b>Note</b> - Do not allow any adhesives to cure on your hands</p>
<p><b>Sealers</b></p>	<p><b>*Do not seal this system</b></p>
<p><b>Post-Installation Cleaning Guidelines</b></p>	<p><b>Remove Installation Debris</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Use a shop vacuum or leaf blower to clear away any dirt and debris left behind after installation.</li> </ul> <p><b>Address Surface Residue</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Tiles may have a water-based mold release residue from the manufacturing process. This is normal and can cause slight discoloration and slipperiness initially.             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ For quick removal, clean the surface using JUGANDO Cleaner or a neutral cleaner. Agitate with a brush or mop, then rinse thoroughly with water. Do not power wash.</li> <li>○ Natural exposure to sunlight and rain will gradually eliminate this residue, but</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

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the process may take up to 4 weeks.

## **Allow Proper UV Exposure**

- Keep movable furniture, planters, and other items off the newly installed surface for at least 48 hours. This ensures the tiles receive adequate UV light for even initial color adjustment.

## **General Maintenance**

- JUGANDO requires less maintenance and routine cleaning.
- The most common methods of cleaning are sweeping, blowing and/or hosing off the surface.
- If excessively dirty, apply a solution of neutral cleaner and water and agitate with a brush then rinse with a garden hose.
- Do NOT use solvents or pressure washers.
