





hat is a rain garden? It's one solution for that low spot in your yard – the one place where all the rain puddles and stays soggy for days. That special low space can be turned into a rain garden which is both beautiful and practical: filtering rainwater runoff and providing a home to birds and butterflies. Any low spot or depression in your yard that is at least 10 feet from your home can be turned into a rain garden. Our Houston gumbo soil is perfect for a rain garden since it holds water well.

Select plants that can tolerate wet sites. Native plants or plants that are found near ponds work best, and seedlings are easier to establish than direct-sown seed when you are going to make a rain garden. For that reason, also try to use native grasses and rushes in at least one-third to one-half of the rain garden.

The final step to making a rain garden – arrange your plants spacing according to label directions. Water well and mulch. Now enjoy your rain garden. ❖


San Antonio

Our Native Heritage Runs Deep



A hunter gathers the people, where they roamed seasonally from the gulf coast in the summer, catching fish and indulging on cattail roots, berries, turtles and seabird eggs. When fall came, they moved back to our area to hunt bison deer and filled their pack with pecans, black walnuts persimmons and fresh fish from the streams.


They thrived until the early 1800's when sickness from diseases from the Europeans moving into the area almost totally wiped them out.

Lasting another decade, they moved to Southeast Louisiana, to join with their sister tribe, the Atalapa who spoke the same distinct language. They have been gone for two hundred years but their memory can be found in the artifacts which still can be found along the Spring and Cypress creek banks.

ating as far back as 13,000 BC, tools and artifacts have been found on the Spring and Cypress creek banks as a rich story of the native heritage of our area unfolds.

Before the pirates, and land grabbers, before the slave traders and wild mustangs which roamed our area, the predecessors of the Akokisa tribe made a home in our area.

The Akokisa Indians were here when the Allen Brothers arrived and laid claim to the land that is now Houston. They lived on the banks of the many streams that crisscross our area including Cypress and Spring Creek.
