How to Use Total Grading

- 1. Simply go to totalgrading. Click services and choose your preferred service. To purchase a service level, simply click 'add to cart', select the quantity for each card that you require and add them to cart. Once completed you will have your order number to fill in the submission form. The postage paid for at this point is for the return of your cards to you once graded.
- 2. Fill in the submission form which can be found on the website. Either print and fill in and include in the package when you send the cards or send an email with your order number to support@totalgrading.co.uk with the submission form attached.
- 3. Pack the cards in penny sleeves and then toploader/semi rigged for extra protection. Get 2 pieces of card to put the cards in between. Use bubble wrap as additional protection before packing. Pack in a box or envelope and add extra packing to protect your cards.
- 4. Send your cards using an insured service to our address on the confirmation email which is Total Grading, 16 Hazel Grove, Essington, Wolverhampton, WV11 2SJ

PLEASE SEND YOUR PARCELS WITH ADEQUATE INSURANCE

If you are using Royal Mail, we recommend using next day delivery to ensure your cards are tracked, and arrive quickly.

5. Sit back and await for your submission to come back to you. You will be notified by ourselves and Royal Mail when your parcel is ready for shipping back to you
