LEARNING OBJECTIVES

TEAM SRG LEADERSHIP INSTITUTE (TSRGLI) program is designed for pastors, leaders, and members of the local church who wish to earn a degree in Christian ministry or pursue individual courses through the Ladderized Education Program (LEP). This program allows students to begin with seminary courses that are creditable toward a college degree and continue for one or two additional years to complete their studies.

Modules:

Each course has six modules to complete. The first four modules are called the General Modules and compulsory to all students. The last two modules are called the Specialization Modules. These modules cover specific, practical areas of pastoral ministry under the same below list of categories:

- specialized ministries;
- specialized pastoral care;
- evangelism and outreach;
- other topics.

A minimum of two modules from each category is required. (No more than three modules may be from any one category.) Modules will ordinarily involve as scheduled by the instructor. Credit will be assigned for modules. Student attendance is required, and assigned reading assignments.

Prior Learning and Life Experience Credit:

Traditionally, college credits are earned in formal classrooms within the academic semester. However, TSRGLI believes that extrainstitutional learning and life experiences can also be valid for college credit and therefore awards credit for relevant work duties, volunteer work, non-credit courses, seminars, and workshops. This feature could significantly reduce the amount of time it will take you to earn your Bachelor's Degree Program.



DEGREE REQUIREMENTS

The Bachelor of Theology is a 120-credit program (without a prior Bachelor's degree), or (ii) a 90-credit program (holder of any bachelor's degree) or (iii) a 60-credit program (for those who are pastoring for at least 10 years).

Students must achieve satisfactory academic standing (a grade of 2.5 or better) in all required courses and the complementary courses specified in year three, and accumulate sufficient acceptable credits to make a total of either 60 or 90-credits, in order to receive their degree.

It should be noted that students who take the AB(BA) Theology program as part of the Master of Divinity program need to maintain a minimum CGPA of 2.5 to be eligible for the M.Div. degree. Normally the program credits must be earned within two years from the date of entrance.

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

1. At least 18 years old
2. Christian for at least 2 years
3. Evidence of involvement in ministry
4. Evidence of call to ministry and service
5. Endorsement by church leadership



GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

1. Completion of 126 credit program studies excluding field education.
2. Minimum GPA of 2.5
3. Term paper/Research Paper

Applicant enrollee are expected to be at least high school graduate or have successfully complete High School Equivalency Exam (ALS) before being allowed to enroll for the baccalaureate level.

HOW LONG WILL IT TAKE TO COMPLETE THIS COURSE?

AB Theology course will roughly take 720 hours to complete, with each of the 6 modules taking on average 2-4 hours a day to complete. The learning experience will be most effective when you finish at least one lesson per week.
