

# Federal Funding Programs for School Safety

There are multiple funding programs from the Federal Government to help increase the safety of our nation's schools. Not all funds and grants operate the same way. Here is a quick summary of key information on Federally Funded Grant programs to help enhance school safety. While funding is subject to the annual appropriations process, we anticipate similar grant programs and funding to be available.

The federal agencies provide significant resources to aide in grant application. Please visit the websites listed for the grants to learn more about applying. In addition to these federal programs, many states have implemented school safety programs. Federal funding can often be combined with state funding.

## **Urban Area Security Initiative**

*Department of Homeland Security*

This program provides funding to enhance regional preparedness and capabilities in designated high-threat, high-density areas.

*Requires State Administrative Agency (SAA) submission*

**2024 funding:** \$553.5 million

## **Nonprofit Security Grant Program**

*Department of Homeland Security*

Support for target hardening and other physical security enhancements and activities to nonprofit organizations that are at high risk of terrorist attack.

*Requires State Agency submission*

### **2024 closing date for applications:**

06/24

**2024 funding:** \$274.5 million

## **State Homeland Security Grant Program**

*Department of Homeland Security*

Includes a suite of risk-based grants to assist state, local, tribal, and territorial efforts in preventing, protecting against, mitigating, responding to, and recovering from acts of terrorism and other threats.

*Requires State Agency submission*

### **2024 closing date for applications:**

Established by the SAA

**2024 funding:** \$373.5 million

## **School Violence Prevention Program (SVPP)**

*Department of Justice*

Improve security at schools and on school grounds in the jurisdiction of the grantee through evidence-based school safety programs and technology.

*Requires 25% minimum cost sharing or matching*

06/11

**2024 funding:** \$73 Million
