SAND TRAPS: USGA RULE 19.3: Relief for a ball unplayable in a bunker.

A player decides that his or her ball in a bunker is unplayable. The player has four (4) options:

- 1) For one penalty stroke, the player may take stroke and distance relief. (back where you hit it from)
- 2) For one penalty stroke, the player may take-back-on-the-line relief in the bunker.
- 3) For one penalty stroke, the player may take lateral relief in the bunker. (2 club lengths)
- 4) For a total of two penalty strokes, the player may take back-on-the-line relief outside the bunker based on a reference line going straight back from the hole through the spot of the original ball.
