### YOUTH WAGE AND DRIVER TRAINING SUBSIDIES

Trucking HR Canada's Career ExpressWay Program offers two new support streams for employers looking to hire and train young people into the trucking and logistics sector:

#### **Youth Wage Subsidy**

Up to \$9,750 in wage subsidy for driving and non-driving positions

#### **Training Subsidies for New Driver Recruits**

Up to \$10,000 in driver training subsidy

The program is open to all Canadian trucking and logistics employers who are looking to hire young people in both driving and non-driving positions.

Partners in our **Wage-Subsidy for Youth** will be reimbursed up to 100% of the salary available to be paid to the employee, up to a maximum of \$9,750 per employee.

Our **Driver Training Subsidy** offers up to \$10,000 in support to cover the cost of driver training to obtain a class 1 or AZ commercial driver license.
