1. SPECIAL UPDATE - COVID-19

Uzbekistan receives additional 500 thousand doses of Sino-Uzbek vaccine

From April 1 to May 18, 1,412,312 doses of the vaccine were used. According to the Ministry of Health, 1,125,995 people were vaccinated at the first stage, and 286,317 – at the second stage.

3.1 LOCAL LEVEL

Uzbekistan's gold and foreign exchange reserves rise for first time since January 2021

International reserves of Uzbekistan as of May 1 amounted to \$34.1 billion, which is 1.5 billion higher compared to April 2021. The main reason is the rising price of gold.

Uzbekistan's public debt decreases in Q1 2021

At the beginning of April 2021, public debt amounted to \$23.2 billion or 40.1% of GDP and decreased by \$133.7 million compared to the beginning of the year.

In January-March 2021, Uzbekistan's economy grew by 3% in relation to the corresponding period of 2020.

4.5 AGRICULTURE AND FOOD

IFC issues a loan to Indorama Agro to promote sustainable cotton and improve livelihoods in rural Areas in Uzbekistan

IFC's \$60 million long-term loan to Indorama Agro LLC will help finance the development of about 50,000-hectares of farmland in two regions of Uzbekistan - Syrdarya and Qashqadarya, while also supporting independent farmers through contract farming. The European Bank for Reconstruction and Development (EBRD) is providing a parallel \$60 million long-term loan and a \$10 million short-term loan to the project.

Uzbekistan and Kazakhstan finalizing negotiations on launching the Silk Road Visa


The visa will help to overcome visa, customs and border barriers when tourists cross the borders of neighboring states.
