## **Junior Miss LaSalle Contest Rules & Information**

1. The contestants will be judged on the following criteria: Appearance, Poise, and Personality.
2. Contestants must wear western attire (pants or below knee length skirt or dress acceptable). There should be no visible undergarments, shorts, crop tops, or strapless tops.
3. Each contestant will be asked to answer three (3) questions (which are provided with this sheet) and demonstrate a talent or hobby. (Example: Dance, cheer, speaking, examples of art, acting, etc. - contestants may choose to explain or talk about their talent or hobby if it is not possible to demonstrate!)
4. **ELIGIBILITY:**
  - a. Each young lady must be a student at the Cotulla Independent School District or resident of La Salle County and be passing in grading period prior to contest.
  - b. Contestants must be single and remain so through her reign. (Defined as a girl who is not or never has been married and not pregnant and never been pregnant.)
  - c. Contestants must currently be in grades 5 through 7.
  - d. Contestants must have parents or guardians' signatures to enter the contest.
  - e. Contestants must reside with parents or guardians at time of application for Junior Miss LaSalle, and during their entire reign as Junior Miss LaSalle.
  - f. Contestants must have previously participated in and have an entry in at least one of this year's LaSalle County Fair events (Essay, Animals, Science Fair, Arts, Foods, etc), and must comply with the general rules of that entered contest.
  - g. The contestant must be in good standing in behavior and academic performance.
    1. Students who have been assigned to DEAP, suspended, or expelled from school for disciplinary reasons shall not be eligible nor shall students who have been adjudicated in a juvenile court proceeding be eligible to participate.
    2. Students who have previously been in breach of contract with the LaSalle County Fair Association as a Court/Fair Royalty member for disciplinary reasons are not eligible to participate.
    3. The Junior Miss LaSalle and Runner Up shall be required to appear at and help to out all trophies at the La Salle County Cook-Off, Fair, Livestock Show, and Ranch Rodeo. **Junior Miss and Runner Up shall be required to abide by all rules of the LaSalle County Fair Association as directed.**
  - h. **ALL queen's courts are required to wear Sashes provided by Fair Association**
