- 2. **ELIGIBILITY** Entrants must be a La Salle County resident or Cotulla ISD student. All youth must abide by Texas House Bill #72 to be eligible to enter.

3. ENTRY -

- 1. Must be 11"x14" poster board provided by the Fair Association. Homeschoolers may pick up a poster board at the Ramirez/Burks Main office or make arrangements with LCFA.
- 2. Poster must be flat. (No three-dimensional entries).
- 3. Entry must pertain to the theme.
- 4. Each child may only have one entry per year.
- 5. The theme should be prominently displayed at the top, on the front, of each poster
- 6. If the Teacher chooses, the theme may be printed and pasted to the poster, but the theme is the ONLY thing that can be printed. All artwork or word bubbles should be hand-drawn by students.
- 7. Students **ARE NOT** allowed to take the posters home. They must be completed in class.
- 8. Each entry must have the following on the back of the poster board:
