STANDING ORDERS

- All ranks will march when possible while moving around and/or across the parade square.
- Marks of Respect, proper and polite manners should be used.at all appropriate times including:
 - Arriving or Dparting the ship by saluting the quarterdeck.
 - Saluting when passing the National Flag, during the playing of 'O Canada' and 'God Save the King'.
 - At all times when cadets are interacting with corps officers, guests and other dignitaries.
 - Entering and Departing the Ship's Office or Stores.
 - Entering and Departing an area designated as the CO's and/or XO's office.
 - Procedure:
 - Come to attention in front of officer and salute.
 - Offer greeting (ie "Good Evening Sir/Ma'am...").
 - If entering an office space ask for permission to enter.
 - Introduce oneself (New Entry Bloggins reporting...).
 - State your business or question.
 - Ask for Permission to Carry On.
 - Salute the officer and move on.
- The gangway (hallway) outside the gymnasium is a designated non-saluting area.
- Headquarters Division (Hammerhead) is responsible for arriving at the ship no later than 1805 hrs to set up the parade square. Cadets appointed as Gunner and Quartermaster are the cadets in charge of the set up.
- No sharing of Snacks and/or Drinks during Stand Easy between cadets.
