

MARKSMANSHIP AND RANGE

Marksmanship Training & Range Activity

- Marksmanship Training Date/Time:** Saturday, February 21st, 2026, 0900-1600
- Marksmanship Training Location:** Heritage Christian Academy (2003 McKnight Blvd NE, Calgary, AB T2E 6L2)
- Pre-Requisites:** All participants are subject to the approval of the event's Range Safety Officer (RSO).
- Seats Available:** 40 (20 seats reserved for #166 NLCC John A. Hamilton, 20 seats reserved for #219 NLCC Holger Storm)
- Selection Process:** All active cadets may apply for a seat in Marksmanship training. From applications submitted, the RSO will select 20 cadets from each corps to participate, and official participation confirmations will be communicated to successful applicants. All other applicants will be placed on a wait list and notified as such.
- *** Application Deadline: Thursday, February 12, 2026, 2330 *****
- Training:** Marksmanship training will consist of four (4) 75-minute instructional periods covering *The Navy League of Canada Marksmanship Training Module*. Cadets will have one (1) lunch break and two (2) Stand Easy breaks. Course material and handouts will be given to cadets to take home and study for their Marksmanship exam.
- Marksmanship Exam Date/Time:** Saturday, February 28th, 2026, 0930. No one will be permitted into the building after 0930.
- Rig of the Day:** Corps t-shirt and ballcap.
- To Bring:** Blank lined notepad/book/scrap, pencil and eraser, water bottle, a bag lunch, three (3) snacks. Please note: food items cannot be shared with other cadets due to potential health risks.
- Range Activity Date/Time:** Saturday, February 28th, 2026, 0900-1700. No one will be permitted into the building after 0930.
- Range Activity Location:** Heritage Christian Academy (2003 McKnight Blvd NE, Calgary, AB T2E 6L2)
- Pre-Requisites:** Successful completion of Marksmanship training with a passing grade on Marksmanship exam, and situational approval by RSO. The marking of exams will be done immediately upon completion of the exam. PARENTS TO REMAIN ONSITE UNTIL ALL EXAMS ARE MARKED. Any cadets who do not pass the Marksmanship exam will not be able to participate in that day's Range activity and will be required to vacate the premises. Any cadets who do not pass the Marksmanship exam will still be eligible to apply for the next scheduled Marksmanship Training & Range Activity, subject to cadet status, RSO approval, and any future pre-requisites currently undefined.
- Range Activity:** To follow *AB(801)E Range Safety Standing Orders (Rev: July 2025)*.
- Rig of the Day:** Corps t-shirt and ballcap.
- To Bring:** Marksmanship workbook, blank lined notepad/book/scrap, pencil and eraser, a water bottle, a bag lunch, three (3) snacks, a book and/or other quiet activity to pass time. Please note: food items cannot be shared with other cadets due to potential health risks.
