LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT

Greetings to all

I would like to welcome back Lido Key Resident Association members and all the ones who will be returning in the upcoming weeks as season seems to have started early this year (wonder if it has anything to with the weather in other parts of the country). The weather here, for the most part, has been beautiful and will only be more inviting as winter sets in (Being a full time resident I am very biased). It has been a few months since our last newsletter and, to say the least, it has been extremely busy with many important issues concerning Lido Key. I would like to provide everyone an update on the current status of them.

First and foremost is the beach renourishment (Debbie Project) that is going to start very soon. The City put out an Invitation to Bid for contractors who were capable of doing the project. The public bid opening by the City was extended to Friday, December 12th. Once the bids are opened, City staff will review them and hopefully it will be a short time for them to award the contract. Alex Davis-Shaw (City engineer) did a presentation at our last member meeting regarding the process of this project. The City wants the contractor who is awarded the job to be mobilized by the middle of January and be completed before turtle season starts (May 1st). Hopefully, as we are having our annual breakfast meeting (January 17th) we will see the project beginning.

The Army Corps of Engineering 50 year Project is moving forward. As of now, the City engineer's staff is trying to secure easements from the Condos and Hotels on the beach so the ACE will be able to have access to their properties so they can replenish the sand over the course of the life of the project. There is a meeting scheduled for Monday December 15th with all affected parties. This is another step in the process. John Kirker, Pat Nicosia (president of the LKRA Condo Association) and I, along with many of our residents, have been working over the last few years going to the County and City commission meetings, budget meetings, and all the public meetings with the Army Corps of Engineering. I want to personally thank everyone for their support on this extremely important issue. As this project moves forward, we will keep you informed regarding scheduled meetings and any pertinent information that comes out.

In November the city received several proposals by interested parties for the ITN (Invitation to Negotiate) regarding the Lido Pool/Pavilion renovation. The proposals are currently under review by City staff and they should have some news for us shortly.

Some other projects on Lido have happened recently. A few of our streets have been repaved (very much needed). A new condo projected has started on 129 Taft Dr., as well as several new houses.

Recently, several LKRA Board Members have indicated to me they will be stepping down. We have been asking for other members to step up and I am happy to report that we have had some people interest in possibly coming on board. Mary Moss will be letting everyone know at the January meeting who is interested in serving, along who is up for reelection.

That was a lot of information on the serious side of things. Now let's talk fun stuff. First, I hope everyone can attend the January breakfast meeting on January 17th. We have the City Manager tentatively scheduled to give a presentation on the state of the City of Sarasota.
